Lessons from 1 & 2 Peter

In the New Testament book of 1 Peter, the Apostle Peter writes, “So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you must endure many trials for a little while” (1 Peter 1:6). To be a human is to face trials in life. But Peter’s words help us see that, as a follower of Jesus, even in suffering, we can have life. In Chapter 1, verse 3 (NLT), Peter writes, “It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now we live with great expectation ...”

Now we live. What a great message of hope in a chaotic world - *Now we live!* In his letter, Peter gives those who *now live* guidance on *how* to live in this living hope that we have.
